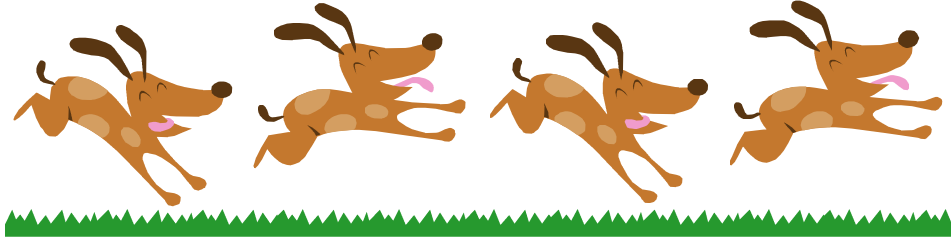


# Shelbyville-Shelby County Parks & Recreation Red Orchard Dog Park



(The Perfect Spot for “Man’s Best Friend”)

Located at 704 Kentucky Street, Shelbyville, this new park for you and your dogs to enjoy will be located in beautiful Red Orchard Park.

Plans for the park include:

- A minimum of two separate double gated areas with 5’ fences for your dog’s safety as well as for the safety and convenience for other park users.
- Dogs will be able to run and play and enjoy the outdoors with other dog friends.
- Water Fountains/Dog waterers (\$1,230-\$2,710)
- Benches (5’ Bench with Name is \$600)
- Various Obstacles for Dogs’ Agility (\$100 - \$ 4,000)
- Shade Structures and Landscaping

There will be two areas; one for smaller dogs and one for larger dogs. A \$5,000 donation would given naming rights to an area. Hopefully, a Land Water Conservation Fund Grant will help finance a major part of the cost. We have received a generous donation of \$ 1,500 from Lifebridge; however, more funds are needed. The total project cost is estimated at \$ 30,000.

Please consider a donation for this new park feature at Red Orchard. Other counties in our area have had a great deal of success with this type area, and we hope Shelby County will benefit from a dog park as well. With your help, we can make it possible.
